- May 4-5, Roadrunner Classic Appaloosa, All Breed & Buckskin Show at Wright's Rockin' Horse Arena in Stanley
- July 27-28, Green Chile Classic Paint, Pinto, Palomino, Appaloosa and All Breed Show at Wright's Rockin' Horse Arena in Stanley
- August 17-18, Red Chile Fiesta at Wright's Rockin' Horse Arena in Stanley
- October 26-27, Fall Color Roundup at Wright's Rockin' Horse Arena in Stanly

## There is NO enrollment or nomination fee! ALL All Breed exhibitors are eligible to win!

An exhibitor (or horse in Open) must show in All Breed class(es) at three or more of the weekend shows listed and at least one show sponsored by each club - NMPHC, NMAPHC, NMPEA and PtHANM or with classes offered for each breed, i.e. Paint, Appaloosa, Palomino or Pinto.

All Breed exhibitor(s) must be a member of one of the sponsoring clubs before any points count towards awards

Points are earned for All Breed class placings under each judge REGARDLESS of how many are in a class. So, EVERY exhibitor in ANY division is eligible to win the High Point Awards. Points will be kept by division and will not be combined from multiple divisions. Points in Open Divisions will be kept on horse (may have multiple exhibitors) and points in Amateur and Youth Divisions will be kept on one horse /one rider

#### Point system:

Placing	Point Earned
1 <sup>st</sup>	120
2 <sup>nd</sup>	105
3 <sup>rd</sup>	91
4 <sup>th</sup>	78
5 <sup>th</sup>	66
6 <sup>th</sup>	55 45
7 <sup>th</sup>	45


Example: If you go in 10 classes and win  $1^{st}$  in all the classes, you will have 1200 points even if you are the only person in your division. If another competitor in a different division goes in 10 classes and gets  $8-1^{st}$ ,  $2-2^{nd}$  out of 4, they will have 1070 points. A third exhibitor goes in 30 classes in a big division and gets  $6^{th}$  in every class, they will have 1650 points. The exhibitor with the 1650 points will win the High Point and the exhibitor with 1200 points will win the Reserve High Point and so on. This point system REWARDS frequency and consistency and makes it possible for any exhibitor in any division to win.

In the event of a tie, the exhibitor & horse (in amateur and youth divisions) or horse (in open divisions) with the most firsts will be used to break the tie. If a tie remains, the highest placing over the greatest number of horses will be used. If a tie still remains, a flip of coin will be used to determine winner.

The boards of the sponsoring clubs reserve the right to clarify rules if needed.
