Ribbons through 6th place & High Points in 9 Divisions

THIS IS AN ALL BREED TRAINING SHOW.

• NO PARKING FEES / NO TIE OUT FEES!

• **IMPORTANT!** Please note that exhibitors must clean up and remove manure & hay before leaving show grounds.

Please use dumpster and NOT the recycling bin.

• Gate adds & scratches allowed. No charge for scratches if made prior to start of class.

• Must check in at office and leave open check or cash to pick up exhibitor numbers.

• No bling required to show! Boots; hat, cap or helmet and long sleeved shirt and pants required.

For English Classes - english saddle, bridle and helmet.

• Trail, Ranch Trail and Showmanship will be in separate arena at exhibitor's convenience (see times posted on class schedule).

• Humane training devices allowed including using two hands with shank bit.

• NMPHC and/or APHA rules prevail if not addressed in show rules. Judges' and/or show management decisions are final.

• Results from this show DO NOT COUNT towards 2026 NMPHC year end awards or the

All Breed Year End Awards Program.

• Cross overs allowed between walk/trot and open (or youth/amateur) classes.

• At this show, CROSS OVERS ARE allowed between ranch classes and traditional horse show classes such as Ranch Trail and Trail or Ranch Pleasure and Western Pleasure.

Youth: 18 & Under (age January 1st, 2026)

Amateur: 19 & Over (see APHA rule #AM-010, page 297-8, 2026 Rulebook)

Open: Any age rider, any skill level

** Green Horse Classes are Open Classes - Horse in 1st or 2nd year of showing in that class or is "green" eligible per APHA or breed rules (usually based on number of national points earned in a specific class, for APHA less than 25 national points).

** Rookie Rider - 1st or 2nd year showing in that specific class (can be open, amateur or youth rider).

** Amateur Riders - must meet APHA amateur requirements.

** Youth age as of January 1, 2026.

** Walk/Trot Rookie and Walk/Trot Green classes are open to ALL Rookie Riders and Green Horses (see definitions above) but the walk/trot high point division awards will be given to those showing in the walk/trot divisions only.
