

Fall Color **ROUNDUP** – October 22 – 23, 2022

Championship Challenge Classes

- NO ENTRY FEE. Horse and exhibitor MUST qualify for Championship Classes by placing 1st or 2nd under either judge in the corresponding all breed or breed class of the same class (such as color, ranch conformation, ranch rail pleasure, western pleasure, etc.). Horse must be shown by same exhibitor who qualified horse for Championship Class unless exhibitor has qualified more than one horse.
Example - to show in the All Breeds Challenge Championship Ranch Conformation, the horse & exhibitor MUST have placed 1st or 2nd under either judge in All Breed Ranch Conformation (open, amateur or youth), in a Paint RR or SPB Ranch Conformation Class (open, amateur or youth), in a Pinto Ranch Conformation Class with color or solid (open, amateur or youth), in a Palomino or Palomino Bred Ranch Conformation Class (open, amateur or youth).
- Championship classes will be judged by one judge (except showmanship where both judge's scores count).
- Prize to winner of each Championship Class. Rosettes through sixth place.
- Championship Classes do NOT count towards any show or year end high point awards.
- If you have questions, please ask. Show management reserves right to clarify Championship Class rules if questions arise. Their decision will be final.

Class #14 – All Color Breeds Challenge Championship to be judged on ideal color representative of breed. Open to qualifying Paint, Palomino and Pinto horses showing in breed color classes.

Class #100 – Showmanship All Breeds Challenge Championship will be based on highest Showmanship score (average from both judges in one class) received in classes 90 – 99.2 (walk/trot classes not included). Tie breaker judge will be chosen by show management. If a tie remains, tie will be broken by highest F&E score. If a tie still remains, tie will be broken by flip of coin until winner is declared. A separate class will not be run.

Class #134 – Ranch Rail Pleasure All Breeds Challenge Championship First and second place horses in each Ranch Rail Pleasure class (walk/trot classes not included) under each judge will return to arena.

Class #162 – Ranch Conformation All Breeds Challenge Championship

Class #236 - Walk/Trot Western Pleasure All Breeds Challenge Championship First and second place horses in each Walk/Trot Western Pleasure class under each judge will return to arena. **This Championship Challenge Class is limited to exhibitors (and horses) showing ONLY in Walk/Trot classes at this show.** If a horse and rider has competed in all breed Walk/Trot and also shows in a Walk/Trot/Lope (or Canter) class in all breed or a breed approved class, they may NOT compete in the Walk/Trot Championship Classes. The horse may have been shown in Walk/Trot/Lope classes with a different exhibitor.

Class #257 – Western Pleasure All Breeds Challenge Championship First and second place horses in each Western Pleasure class (walk/trot classes not included) under each judge will return to arena.

Class #275 – Western Horsemanship All Breeds Challenge Championship First and second place horses in each Western Horsemanship class (walk/trot classes not included) under each judge will return to arena for rail work only.

Class #300 – Hunter under Saddle All Breeds Challenge Championship First and second place horses in each Hunter under Saddle class (walk/trot classes not included) under each judge will return to arena.
