\*\* Amateur Riders - must meet APHA amateur requirements.

\*\* Youth age as of January 1, 2024.

\*\* Walk/Trot Rookie and Walk/Trot Green classes are open to ALL Rookie Riders and Green Horses (see definitions above) but the walk/trot high point division awards will be given to those showing in the walk/trot divisions only.

◆ NMPHC and/or APHA rules to prevail when not addressed on class list or in show rules.

◆ Show Management reserves the right to run classes concurrently and clarify rules if needed. Their decision is final.

◆ This is NOT a training show - No training devices allowed.

◆ At this show, CROSS OVERS ARE allowed between ranch classes and traditional horse show classes such as Ranch Trail and Trail and Ranch Pleasure and Western Pleasure.

### **High Point Awards**

◆ All Show High Point Division Awards are based on one horse/one rider except for the Open Divisions which are based on horse (can have multiple riders).

◆ Since cross overs are allowed between ranch and traditional horse show classes, it is possible for one horse (in open divisions) or one horse and rider team (in all other divisions) to win a High Point Ranch Award and a High Point Traditional Horse Show Award.

◆ High Point winners will earn points which can be used to "purchase" awards from the 2024 NMPHC Show Awards Catalog. Points can be used as earned or saved up to combine with points from the Green Chile Classic in July and/or Red Chile Fiesta in August.
