GENERAL SHOW RULES:

- Classes will be governed by appropriate breed association and/or state and local club rules.
- Show management reserves the right to combine and/or cancel classes based on APHA and/or PHBA rules.
- Youth classes will be held with one entry or combined as allowed by breed rules.
- Open and Amateur classes with one entry may be canceled or combined where allowed.
- Questions concerning rules and fees as published may be presented to Show Management for clarification. In the event of typographical errors in class list, fee schedule, forms and show info; the corrected spelling or intended meaning shall be substituted. Show Management decisions will be final.

Stalls and indoor arena at Wright's will NOT be available for move-in or schooling prior to 5 pm on Friday, March 31st, without prior approval of show management.

- **PLEASE NOTE THIS IS NOT A TRAINING SHOW AND TRAINING DEVICES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CLASS.**
- To keep the show running smoothly, please notify gate person of any tack changes. Have you tack ready at the gate.
- There will be a two minute gate for all classes. No exceptions.
- There are no speakers in the barn areas or the parking lots at Wright's. Please stay alert and listen to announcements made in the horse arena regarding class times.
- Show management reserves the right to change arenas and schedule due to weather and/or other circumstances.
- Please be aware that email, texting and internet access at Wright's (especially in the indoor arena and barn) is NOT instantaneous communication.
- While show management will do its best to keep all exhibitors informed, it is ultimately the exhibitors' responsibility to be ready at the gate when their class is called.
- Exhibitors requiring special accommodations should consult their breed association rulebooks or 4-H rules for procedures regarding applying for variances. If not covered by breed rules, APHA rules will prevail.

ENTRIES:

ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON A PROPERLY COMPLETED AND SIGNED ENTRY FORMS and A PROPERLY COMPLETED AND SIGNED RELEASE & WAIVER MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES (on entry form).

Please complete one form per horse.

- **PRE ENTRIES are highly recommended but not required for Palomino and All-Breed classes.** A discounted Office fee of \$20.00 is available for exhibitors submitting completed entry form with horse, owner and exhibitor information along with copies of registration papers and membership cards (for Palomino horses) and entering at least one class by March 24th. Pre-payment not required.
- PLEASE send pre-entries for Palomino and All Breed classes to the show secretary: Kathryn Erickson, 134 Rambla de Caballo, Stanley, NM 87056 or email: kathrynerickson9@gmail.com
- Pre- entries must be RECEIVED by March 24th to receive discounted office fee. Please allow transit time for mailed entries to be received by March 24th. Entries and additional classes may be made at show.
- Pre-entry will speed up check in and entry process on day of show and save you money. Office fee if entering after March 24th is \$30.00
- Pre-payment of entry fees or stalls is not required.
- **PRE ENTRIES REQUIRED for 4-H Entries and must be received no later than March 24. At least one class must be entered and 4-H participants may add/scratch classes at the gate or office prior to start of class.**
- Adding or scratching classes for horses entered in show must be done in office or at gate before a class begins or the gate is closed and must be on properly completed add/scratch forms.
 - **Scratches at the gate** – If made on an add/scratch form prior to a class, entry fee for that class will not be charged.
 - If for any reason you do not scratch a class and are considered a “NO SHOW” causing a delay in the show, you will be charged your office fee and for the classes entered. Please contact the Show Contact, Show Secretary or Show Manager listed on page 1 by phone, text or email if you have pre-entered and cannot make it to the show for any reason.
 - **Adds at the gate** – If adding any classes at the gate, please review your bill before closing out your tab to verify the class has been added to your bill. There is sometimes a delay between the class being run and the office getting a final tally for the class. Exhibitors will be billed for all classes entered.
- By bringing horses (equines) to this event, I (we) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/responsible party(ies) agree to abide by the by- laws, standing rules, judging, & show rules (including but not limited to sportsmanship & responsible conduct) of the NMPHC, APHA (American Paint Horse Assoc.), NMPEA and PHBA (Palomino Horse Breeders of

America). The owners/exhibitors/responsible parties release NMPHC, APHA, NMPEA, PHBA & their respective members, Wright's Rockin' Horse Arena & their owner/operators from any loss to myself, dependents, employees, agents, horses, &/or equipment while attending &/or participating in this show. They must also acknowledge & accept responsibility for any damage to stalls/tack rooms & facility which results in charges to show management. Owners/exhibitors/responsible parties must also acknowledge that they have read & understand show rules as outlined in breed rule books, the "Spring Salsa Sensation Horse Show Information" and in this waiver of liability. The provisions contained therein are hereby made a part of any agreement to participate at this event.

ENTRY FEES:

- ALL Classes will be single judged.
- See entry fee schedules and class lists for all fees including any Special Fees and/or All Inclusive Fees.
- Palomino Youth paying an all show Youth fee are eligible to show in W/T, Novice & Youth – same horse & rider AND must meet eligibility requirements for that division and possess appropriate membership cards, i.e. Walk/Trot exhibitors cannot show in Walk/Trot/Lope classes but can show in Halter, Color, In Hand Trail and Showmanship. Consult your breed association rulebook. Please ask if you have questions before you enter and show.
- Payment of all fees (either by cash or with signed check payable to NMPHC) is required prior to picking up exhibitor number(s) at show office. Due to the multiple special and breed fees, billing statements cannot be generated until all horse, owner and exhibitor(s) information and all fees (including stalls, breed fees, equipment fees, etc.) and class entries are input into the show software program. Pre-entries are encouraged. Bills will not be hand calculated.
- There will be a \$30.00 charge to owner/exhibitor for any checks returned by a banking institution for any reason.
- **Important!!! ENTRIES IN MULTIPLE DIVISIONS WILL NOT BE COMBINED FOR ALL SHOW FEES except as listed in the ALL INCLUSIVE FEES!**

YOU CAN REGISTER YOUR PALOMINO OR PALOMINO BRED AT THIS SHOW and SHOW AT THIS SHOW!

- FYI – NM Palomino Exhibitor Associations Representatives will be onsite Friday evening before the show to assist with Palomino registrations. You can pay your membership and register your horse or complete paperwork Friday evening and then SHOW AT THIS SHOW!
- GREAT IDEA IF YOU WANT TO GET PALOMINO OR PALOMINO BRED PAPERS ON YOUR HORSE!
- PHBA has revised registration rules recently to allow PHBA registration of mares and stallions (without known bloodlines) that possess palomino color and characteristics AND has expanded Palomino Bred Registry to accept Palominos with excessive white, i.e., your Palomino Paint (no requirement for Palomino parent).
- GET IT DONE PRIOR TO THE SHOW and take advantage of pre-entry discount! PLEASE call and make arrangements prior to show date. Contact Berniece at viabz@aol.com or 505-702-2246 (text or leave message).
- SPECIAL NOTE: The PHBA Registration Special Prices are available through April 30th. Take advantage of the special prices and register your horse at this show!

CONCURRENT CLASSES:

Show management reserves the right to run classes concurrently when possible at this show. When classes are run concurrently, you are NOT required to enter all of the classes which will run concurrently. You may enter only the class(es) you choose and will only earn points (towards show awards, state points and national points) in the class(es) you entered and paid an entry fee; i.e. if you enter an All Breed Class running concurrently with a 4-H Class, you must enter and pay for both classes if you want to earn points for both the All Breed and 4-H classes. National, state and/or show points will be reported and calculated using the number of horses entered in your class, not using the total number of horses in the concurrent class. Only enter PHBA classes if your horse has PHBA registration papers or you have provided paperwork that shows that registration has been applied for and you (and owner) have membership

cards. PHBA (Palomino) memberships can be paid at show prior to showing. Palomino horses can be registered prior to showing – see info in outlined box above.

Please ask if you have questions. You CANNOT post enter a class.

CROSS ENTERING CLASSES:

- PHBA EXHIBITORS in PHBA approved classes may NOT show in PHBA association walk/trot classes and walk/trot/lope (canter) classes at the same event. If showing in a PHBA walk/trot class, EXHIBITOR cannot show in a PHBA or All Breed walk/trot/lope (canter) or 4-H class at this show but can show in Halter, Color, In Hand Trail and Showmanship. HORSE may be shown by another exhibitor in walk/trot/lope (canter) classes.
- The **All Breed walk/trot classes** are open to all exhibitors (except leadline exhibitors). Please see rules concerning W/T All Breed Division High Point Awards.
- Leadline Classes
 - Youth may NOT cross enter leadline and mounted walk/trot or walk/trot/lope (canter) classes.
 - For the All Breed Leadline Class, assistance by side walkers or spotters is allowed.
- Please consult your 2023 breed association rulebook for ranch class rules and the restrictions (if any) on cross entering other classes such as Ranch Rail Pleasure and Western Pleasure. Not all the breeds have the same rules concerning cross-entries. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to enter the correct classes.
- All Breed and 4-H exhibitors may cross enter All Breed and 4-H ranch and traditional show classes.
- APHA, PHBA and NMPHC rules to prevail.
- **4-H Classes will be governed by NM State 4-H rules.**

STALL RESERVATIONS & PARKING:

- Stall reservations required for a guaranteed stall. Show sponsors will be given preferential stall assignments.
- ALL horses (equines) must complete a stall reservation form whether stalling at show grounds or working out of trailer, whether showing or not. If a stall form is not completed, a stall fee will be charged for each day on the show grounds.
- Please send stall reservation and RV/LQ reservation forms to Ron Morris, PO Box 908, Belen, NM 87002 Mailed forms must be received by Wednesday, March 29th.
- Stalls and indoor arena at Wright's will NOT be available for move in or schooling prior to 5 pm on Friday, March 31st, without prior approval of show management.
- There are 20 acres of available parking. Please do not park closer than 12 feet from the trailer nearest yours. If you are working out of your trailer, please distance even more than that. Show staff will be on the grounds to enforce this.
- If you have not been assigned trailer parking, please back your trailer in perpendicular to fence west of arena or south of stalls.

CATTLE RESERVATIONS:

\$45 per head/per go in Ranch Cow Work and Boxing classes. \$60 per class/per horse in Cutting classes. Cattle reservations with pre-payment are due March 24th. Show management reserves right to cancel cattle classes if insufficient cattle have been reserved and cattle fees will be refunded if classes are canceled by show management. Cattle fees are non-refundable. Ultimate decision on any refunds will be made by show management.

FOR ALL CUTTING CLASSES: Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own turn back and herd holders.

Failure to do so will result in contestant not being allowed to show and no refunds will be given. Two minute gate call will be strictly enforced.

HORSE SHOW AWARDS

Ribbons will be given for first through sixth place in each class and for Grand & Reserve halter classes and will be available in the office.

MINIMUM OF 20 HIGH POINT DIVISION AWARDS OFFERED (including 4-H)!

- **PHBA (Palomino) and All Breed Divisions** - High Point and Reserve High Point winners will be able to select an award from the 2023 NMPHC Show Awards Catalog. Each division high point and reserve will earn points that can be used to “purchase” an award or “saved” to pool with points earned at our Green Chile Classic (July) and Red Chile Fiesta (August) shows. Check out some award samples in the show awards catalog at the show or online www.nmpainthorse.org/about. Membership NOT required to be eligible for show awards. Note: there is a September 30th deadline for ordering (purchasing) show awards. After this deadline has passed, high point award values will be donated to the NMPHC scholarship fund.
- High point results may not be available at the conclusion of show on Sunday. Results will be posted as soon as possible on facebook pages and club websites.
- Show High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been totaled and audited for each division (halter & color points are counted in point totals within a division as designated below).
- Leadline does not count towards any show high point awards.

PHBA and All Breed Divisions –

- Membership NOT required to be eligible for show awards.
- In the event of a tie for a high point or reserve division award, the entry with the most firsts will be declared the winner. If a tie remains, the entry with the highest placing over the greatest number of horses will be used to break the tie. If a tie still remains, a flip of a coin will be used to determine the winner.

To qualify for High Point and Reserve High Point Division Awards:

OPEN Palomino, Palomino Bred (if held) and All Breed – must show in a minimum of Four (4) Classes in a division. Points kept on horse in Open Divisions. Can have multiple riders (exhibitors). Halter and Color points are included in high point tabulation.

WALK/TROT OPEN All Breed – Must show in a minimum of Four (4) Classes in this division. Points kept on horse in Open Divisions. Can have multiple riders (exhibitors). Halter points DO NOT count in this division. While Walk/Trot classes are open to all horses and exhibitors, the Walk/Trot High Point Awards are limited to horses showing only in Walk/Trot classes.

GREEN HORSE (horse’s 1st of 2nd year of showing) - must show in a minimum of Four (4) Classes in this division. Points kept on horse in Open Divisions. Can have multiple riders (exhibitors). Halter points DO NOT count in this division.

WALK/TROT GREEN HORSE (horse’s 1st of 2nd year of showing) - must show in a minimum of Four (4) Classes in this division. Points kept on horse in Open Divisions. Can have multiple riders (exhibitors). Halter points DO NOT count in this division. While the Walk/Trot Green Horse classes are open to all green horses (as defined), the Walk/Trot High Point Awards are limited to horses showing only in Walk/Trot classes.

ROOKIE RIDER (rider’s 1st or 2nd year showing in that class) - must show in a minimum of Four (4) Classes in this division. Points kept on horse & rider team in the rookie division. Halter points DO NOT count in this division.

WALK/TROT ROOKIE RIDER (rider’s 1st or 2nd year showing in that class) - must show in a minimum of Four (4) Classes in this division. Points kept on horse & rider team in the rookie division. Halter points DO NOT count in this division. While the Walk/Trot Rookie Rider classes are open to all rookie riders (as defined), the Walk/Trot High Point Awards are limited to exhibitors showing only in Walk/Trot classes.

AMATEUR Palomino, Palomino Bred (if held) and All Breed – Must show in a minimum of Four (4) Classes in a division. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Amateur Divisions. Amateur Halter and Color points are included in high point tabulation.

WALK/TROT AMATEUR Palomino, Palomino Bred (if held) & All Breed – Must show in a minimum of Three (3) Classes. Halter and Color points DO NOT count in these divisions. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Amateur Divisions. While the All Breed Walk/Trot Amateur classes are open to all amateur exhibitors, the Walk/Trot High Point Awards are limited to exhibitors showing only in Walk/Trot classes.

YOUTH Palomino, Palomino Bred (if held) and All Breed – Must show in a minimum of Four (4) Classes in a division. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Youth Divisions. Youth Halter and Color (if offered) points are included in high point tabulation. In Palomino and All Breed Youth classes run as 18 & Under, youth points will be split into the appropriate age group: 13 & Under and 14-18. Palomino Bred (if held) Youth Awards will be 18 & Under.

WALK/TROT YOUTH All Breed – Must show in a minimum of Three (3) Classes in this division. Halter points DO NOT count in this division. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Youth Divisions. While the All Breed Youth Walk/Trot classes are open to all youth exhibitors and horses, the Walk/Trot High Point Awards are limited to youth exhibitors showing only in Walk/Trot classes.

REMINDER!! TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR YEAR END HIGH POINT AWARDS IN NM PAINT HORSE CLUB, OR NM PALOMINO EXHIBITORS ASSOC. YOU MUST BE A MEMBER!! PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR CLUB FOR ALL REQUIREMENTS!

ALL BREED YEAR END AWARDS: NMPHC counts All Breed results towards NMPHC All Breed year end awards provided membership is paid and volunteer requirement is met (or work fee paid). All Breed Results can be used for NMPEA year end awards program for Palomino, Palomino Bred and All Breed Awards if horse is enrolled in the NMPEA year end awards program.
