All equines from minis to drafts including mules and donkeys are welcome!

#### **PLUS.....**

- ALL CLASSES count towards the 2024 ALL BREED YEAR END AWARDS PROGRAM co-sponsored by the NM Paint, Pinto, Palomino and Appaloosa Clubs. Exhibitor must be a member of one of the sponsoring clubs before any points count towards these awards.
- All breed classes qualify for year end awards in NM Paint Horse Club and the NM Palomino Exhibitors Assoc.
- All breed classes are eligible for credits or points in breed association programs such as:
  - o PAC (Paint Alternative Competition)
  - OTT (Pinto On The Trail Recreational Pinto Program)
  - OCAP (Pinto Open Competition Activities Program)
  - o P3 eligible (Palomino Performance Program)
  - ACAAP (Appaloosa Competitive All-Breed Activities Program)
  - o And more.....
- Contact your local NM club or visit their websites or facebook pages for complete year end award rules for each breed.

Numerous food vendors are available 5-10 minutes away. NO onsite food truck at this event.

#### **GENERAL SHOW RULES:**

- Gates open at 6:30 am. Office opens at 7 am. Show starts at 8 am.
- Classes will be governed by APHA (American Paint Horse Association) or NMPHC (New Mexico Paint Horse Club) rules unless specifically stated otherwise in the class list or these rules. Judge's decisions will be final.
- No bling required! Boots, belt, hat or helmet, long sleeved shirt and pants required. English attire for hunter under saddle classes.
- No parking or tie-out fees
- Every horse or equine on the show grounds must complete an entry form whether showing or not.
- Show management reserves the right to combine and/or cancel classes.
  - Youth classes will be held with one entry.
  - o Open, Green, Amateur and Rookie classes with one entry may be canceled or combined.
- Questions concerning rules and fees as published may be presented to Show Management for clarification. In the event of typographical errors in class list, fee schedule, forms and show info; the corrected spelling or intended meaning shall be substituted. Show Management decisions will be final.
- PLEASE NOTE THIS IS NOT A TRAINING SHOW AND TRAINING DEVICES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CLASS.

- To keep the show running smoothly, please notify gate person of any tack changes. Have you tack ready at the gate.
- There will be a two minute gate for all classes. No exceptions.
- While show management will do its best to keep all exhibitors informed, it is ultimately the exhibitors' responsibility to be ready at the gate when their class is called.
- If you might have a conflict between classes in both arenas, please let the paddock or gate person and office know. We'll do our best to accommodate you.
- Show management reserves the right to change arenas and schedule due to weather and/or other circumstances.
- Exhibitors requiring special accommodations should contact the show manager prior to April 20<sup>th</sup>. APHA rules for procedures regarding applying for variances will prevail.

#### **ENTRIES:**

ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON A PROPERLY COMPLETED AND SIGNED ENTRY FORMS and A PROPERLY COMPLETED AND SIGNED RELEASE & WAIVER MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES (on entry form).

#### Please complete one entry form per horse.

- An entry form and signed liability statement is required for every horse or equine on show grounds whether showing or not.
- If you are competing for the 2024 All Breed Awards Program co-sponsored by the NM Paint, Pinto, Palomino and Appaloosa Clubs, please be sure to use the same name for horse at all shows so that results can be tracked.
- PRE ENTRIES are highly recommended but not required. A discounted Office fee of \$15.00 is available for exhibitors submitting completed entry form with horse, owner and exhibitor information and entering at least one class by April 20th. Pre-payment not required.
- Entries can be made at the show and additional classes may be added at show.

- Pre- entries must be RECEIVED by April 20th to receive discounted office fee. Please allow transit time for mailed entries to be received by April 20th.
- Pre-entry will speed up check in and entry process on day of show and save you money. Office fee if entering after April 20th is \$20.00
- Adding or scratching classes for horses entered in show can be done in the show office or at the gate with the paddock master BEFORE a class begins or the gate is closed.
  - o Scratches at the gate If made prior to when a class begins, entry fee for that class will not be charged.
  - Please be sure contact the Show Contact, Show Secretary or Show Manager listed on page 1 by phone, text or email if you have pre-entered and cannot make it to the show for any reason. We appreciate your help in keeping the show running smoothly.
  - Adds at the gate If classes have been added at the gate, please review your bill before closing out your tab to verify the class has been added to your bill. There is sometimes a delay between the class being run and the office getting a final tally for the class. Exhibitors will be billed for all classes entered.
- By bringing horses (equines) to this event, the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/responsible party(ies), agree to abide by the by-laws, standing rules, judging and show rules (including but not limited to sportsmanship & responsible conduct) of NMPHC and APHA (American Paint Horse Assoc.). The owners/exhibitors/responsible parties release NMPHC, APHA, & their respective members, the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Posse & their owner/operators from any loss to myself, dependents, employees, agents, horses, &/or equipment while attending &/or participating in this show. They also acknowledge & accept responsibility for any damage to the facility which results in charges to show management. The owners/exhibitors/responsible parties also acknowledge that they have read & understand show rules as outlined in the APHA rule books and the "Spring Salsa Sensation Horse Show Information" and in the waiver of liability. In case of injury, permission is granted for emergency medical treatment. The provisions contained herein are hereby made a part of the agreement.

#### **ENTRY FEES:**

- ALL Classes are open to All Breeds and will be single judged.
- See entry fee schedules and class lists for all fees including any Show Specials and/or Maximum Entry Fees.
- Payment of all fees (either by cash or with signed check payable to NMPHC) is required prior to picking up exhibitor number(s) at show office. Billing statements cannot be generated until all horse, owner and exhibitor(s) information and all fees (including office, trail, cattle, etc.) and class entries are input into the show software program. Pre-entries are encouraged.
- There will be a \$50.00 charge to owner/exhibitor/responsible party for any checks returned by a banking
  institution for any reason. If the check is returned by the bank and is not covered within 30 days, exhibitor,
  owner, responsible party and/or horse will not be allowed to compete at future NMPHC events. See NMPHC
  Year End and Show Rules.

Important!!! ENTRIES IN MULTIPLE DIVISIONS WILL NOT BE COMBINED FOR "MAXIMUM FEES" except as listed in the "SHOW SPECIAL" MAXIMUM FEE PER HORSE!

YOU CAN REGISTER YOUR PINTO, PINTO SOLID, PALOMINO OR PALOMINO BRED AT THIS SHOW!

- FYI A Pinto Horse Association Field Representative will be onsite at the show to register Pintos and Pinto Solids.
- An NM Palomino Exhibitor Assoc. Board Member will be available to assist with Palomino registrations.
- GREAT IDEA IF YOU WANT TO GET PINTO, PINTO SOLID, PALOMINO OR PALOMINO BRED PAPERS ON YOUR HORSE!
  - o Pinto recognizes over 70 outcross breeds and more for horses meeting color requirements.
  - Pinto accepts numerous outcross breeds in the Solid Registry including Quarter Horses,
     Paints, Appaloosas, Arabians and horses with undocumented registry.
  - Palomino registers Palomino horses registered in numerous breeds and undocumented
     Palominos provided they meet conformation and color requirements.
  - o Palomino Bred registration is for horses with at least one registered Palomino registered parent or Palomino horses with excessive white such as regular registry Paints and Pintos.

#### **CROSS ENTERING CLASSES:**

- The walk/trot classes are open to all exhibitors (except leadline exhibitors). Please see rules concerning Walk/Trot All Breed Division High Point Awards.
- Leadline Classes
  - Youth may NOT cross enter leadline and mounted walk/trot or walk/trot/lope (canter) classes.
  - o For the Lead Line Classes, assistance by side walkers or spotters is allowed.
- Ranch classes and traditional show classes MAY be cross entered at this show.

#### **Cattle Reservations:**

\$45 per head/per go in Ranch Cow Work and Boxing classes. \$60 per class/per horse in Cutting classes. Cattle reservations with pre-payment are due April 20th. Show management reserves right to cancel cattle classes if insufficient cattle have been reserved and cattle fees will be refunded. Otherwise, cattle fees are non-refundable. Ultimate decision on any refunds will be made by show management. Late entries may be accepted but exhibitor may have to use re-work cattle.

FOR ALL CUTTING CLASSES: Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own turn back and herd holders. Failure to do so will result in contestant not being allowed to show and no refunds will be given. Two minute gate call will be strictly enforced.

#### HORSE SHOW AWARDS

Ribbons will be given for first through sixth place in each class and will be available in the office.

#### FIFTEEN HIGH POINT DIVISION AWARDS OFFERED!

- Separate High Point awards will be given for Ranch Divisions and the "Traditional" Horse Show Divisions as listed at bottom of Show Fees page along with requirements to qualify for each division.
- The NMPHC State Point System will be used to calculate high point show awards, i.e. 6 or more in a class, 1<sup>st</sup> place 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 5 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place 4 points, etc. through 6 places; if 5 in class, 1<sup>st</sup> place 5 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 4 points, etc.
- High Point winners will be able to select an award from the 2024 NMPHC Show Awards Catalog. Each division high point will earn points that can be used to "purchase" an award or "saved" to pool with points earned at our Green Chile Classic (July) and Red Chile Fiesta (August) shows. From buckles to vests and jackets, from nylon award halters to show halters, engraved glassware, plaques and tumblers, gift cards and lots, lots more, check out some awards available in the show awards catalog at the show or online www.nmpainthorse.org/about.
  Note: there is a September 30<sup>th</sup> deadline for ordering (purchasing) show awards. After this deadline, high point award values will be donated to the NMPHC scholarship fund.
- High point results may not be available at the conclusion of show on Sunday and results will be posted as soon as possible on facebook page and club website.
- Show High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been totaled and audited for each division. It is NOT required to show in halter or conformation classes but halter and conformation points count towards high point totals.
- Leadline classes do not count towards any show high point awards.
- The Walk/Trot High Point Awards are limited to exhibitors showing only in Walk/Trot classes.
- NMPHC membership is NOT required to be eligible for show awards.
- In the event of a tie for a high point division award, the entry with the most firsts will be declared the winner. If a tie remains, the entry with the highest placing over the greatest number of horses will be used to break the tie. If a tie still remains, a flip of a coin will be used to determine the winner.

REMINDER!! TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR YEAR END HIGH POINT AWARDS IN NM PAINT HORSE CLUB, OR NM PALOMINO EXHIBITORS ASSOC. YOU MUST BE A MEMBER!! PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR CLUB FOR ALL REQUIREMENTS!

ALL BREED YEAR END AWARDS: NMPHC counts All Breed results towards NMPHC All Breed year end awards provided membership is paid and volunteer requirements are met (or work fee paid).

All Breed Results can be used for NMPEA year end awards program for Palomino, Palomino Bred and All Breed Awards if horse is enrolled in the NMPEA year end awards program and owner/exhibitor(s) are members.
