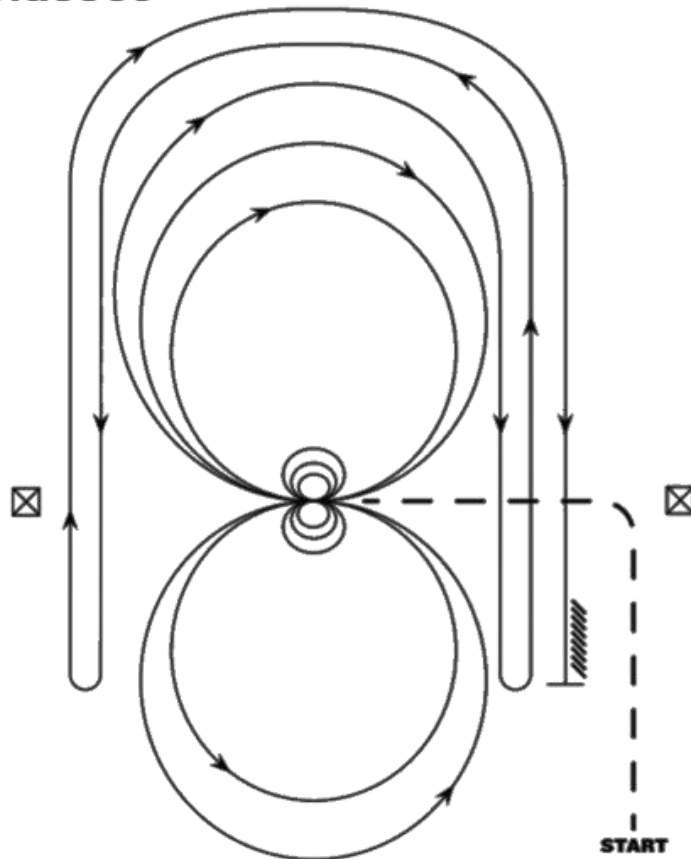


Spring Salsa

All Ranch Reining Classes - RANCH REINING PATTERN 1

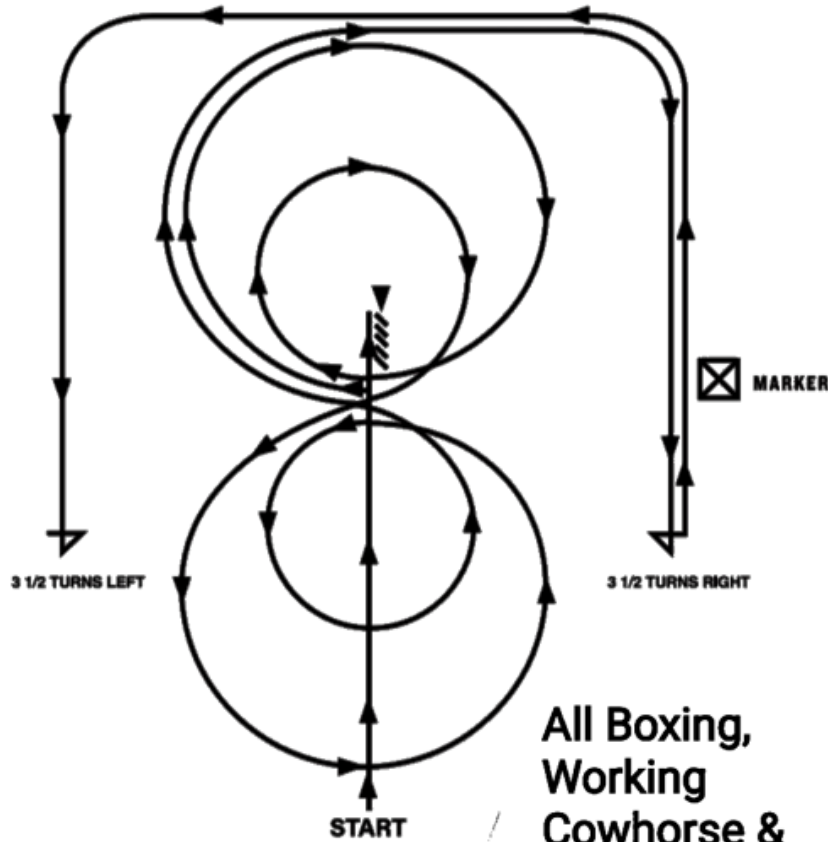


Mandatory Markers along Fence or Wall: The judge shall indicate with markers on arena fence or wall the center of the pattern.

Ride pattern as follows: Trot to center of arena and stop.

1. Complete 3 spins in one direction. Hesitate.
2. Complete 3 spins in the opposite direction. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on right lead, complete two large fast circles to the right. Change leads at center of arena.
4. Complete two large fast circles to the left. Change leads at center of arena.
5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left roll back at least 20 feet from the wall or fence, no hesitation.
6. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right roll back at least 20 feet from the wall or fence, no hesitation.
7. Continue back around previous circle, but do not close this circle. Run down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet from the wall or fence. Back up at least 10 feet. Hesitate to show completion of pattern.

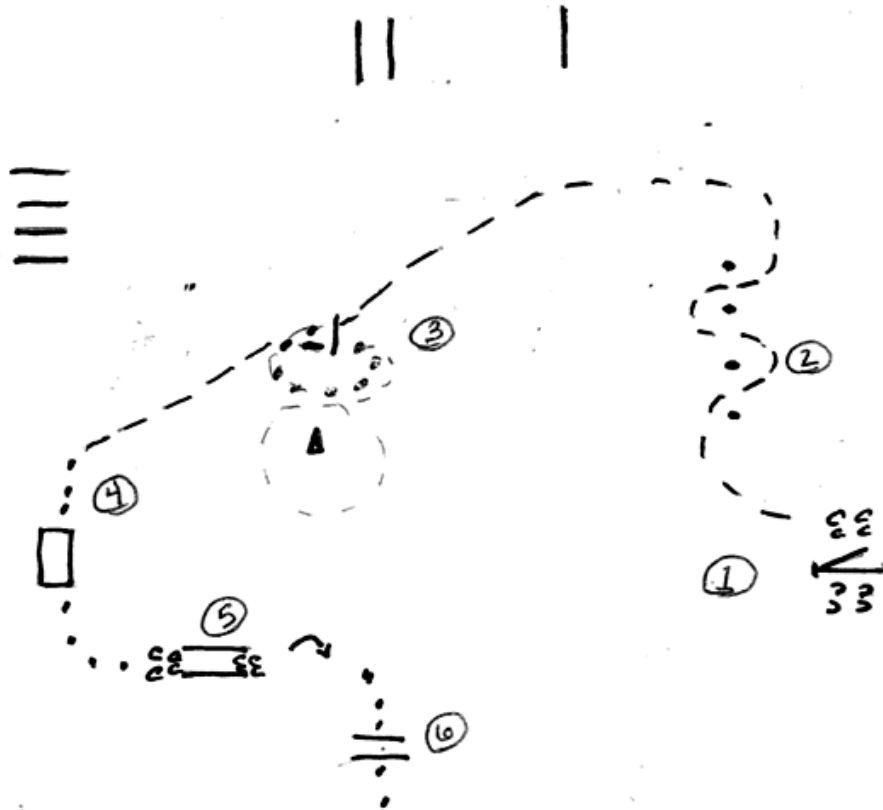

1. Start at end of arena. Run down middle past center marker to a sliding stop. Back at least 10 feet to center. 1/4 turn left.
2. Pick up right lead, large fast circle, small slow circle. Change leads at center of arena.
3. Circling to the left, complete a large fast circle, then a small slow circle. Change leads at center of arena.
4. Start a circle to the right, but do not close this circle. Run around end of arena and down the side (approximately 20 feet from fence) past center marker and come to a sliding stop.
5. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the right.
6. Continue back down side and around end of arena to other side (approximately 20 feet from fence) past center marker and come to a sliding stop.
7. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the left. Hesitate to complete pattern.

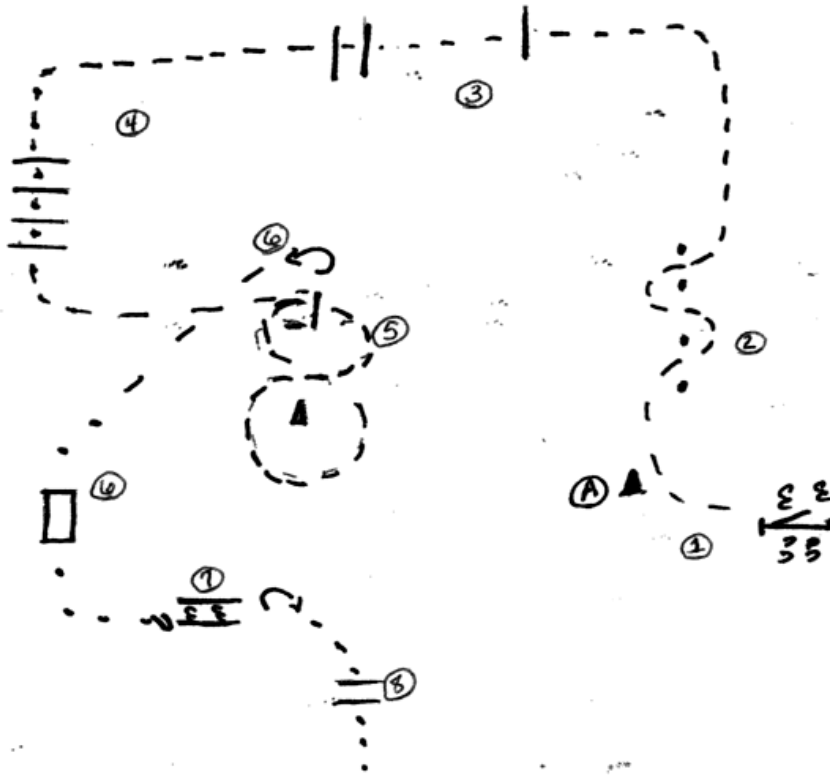


Pinto Yearling In Hand Ranch Fundamentals

1. Left hand push gate.
2. Trot through markers.
3. Extended trot to drag (do not drag), pick up rope & carry in circle around pole as shown at a walk or trot & return rope to upright.
4. Trot to bridge as shown, walk over bridge.
5. Back through chute.
6. Walk over logs to exit.

RANCH TRAIL W/T OPEN - GREEN



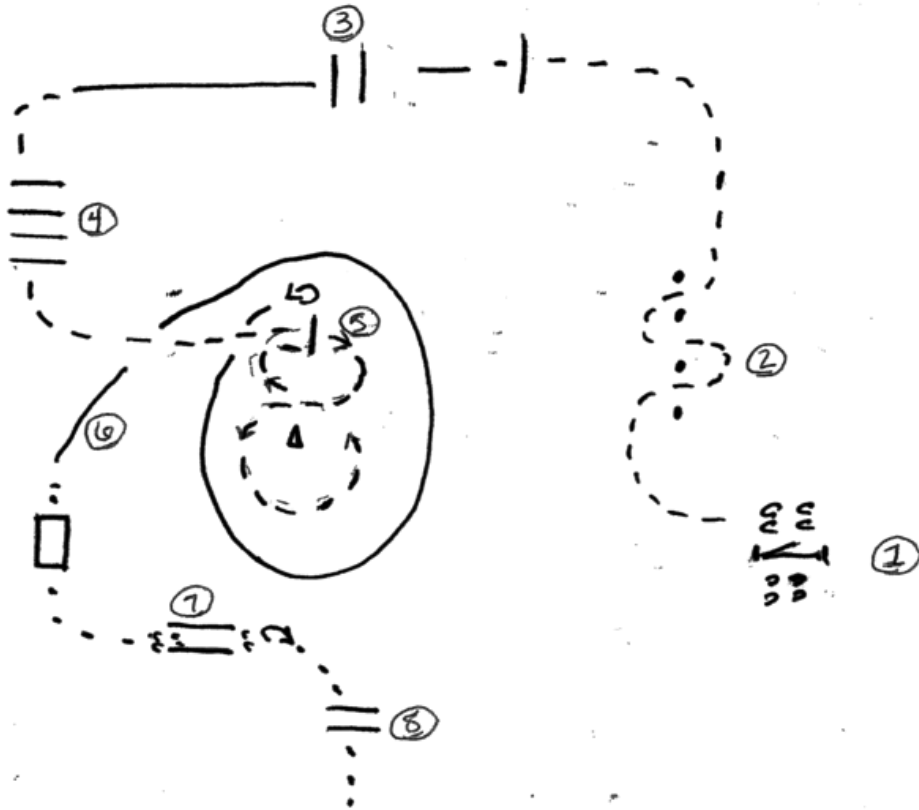
Ranch Trail Walk/Trot – Open & Green Horse

1. Left hand push gate.
2. Trot through markers.
3. Extended trot over logs.
4. Trot logs to drag.
5. Drag log in a figure 8 as shown at a walk or trot.
6. 180 degree pivot left and trot to bridge as shown, walk over bridge.
7. Back through chute.
8. Walk over logs to exit.

Ranch Trail Novice Amateur, Rookie, Novice Youth and Youth

1. Left hand push gate.
2. Trot through markers and over log.
3. Left lead lope over logs.
4. Trot over logs to drag (do not drag).
5. Carry rope in figure 8 as shown at a walk or trot & return rope to upright.
6. 180 degree pivot left and lope circle to bridge as shown, walk over bridge.
7. Back through chute.
8. Walk over logs to exit.

PATTERN 5

- Lope- 150 feet
- Extended Lope- 200 feet
- Ordinary Walk- 30 feet
- Trot- 120 feet
- Stop and Reverse (either direction)
- Extended Trot- 240 feet
- Trot- 90 feet
- Extended Walk- 75 feet
- Lope- 150 feet
- Stop and Back

**For Walk/Trot patterns -
Trot where pattern calls for lope.
Extended trot where pattern calls
for extended lope.**
