Awards to the TOP FIVE All Breed Exhibitors (or Horses) can be from in Any All Breed Division

- High Point Saddle** or \$1000 (**winner may upgrade or customize saddle at their expense)
- Reserve High Point
- 3rd Place
- 4th Place
- 5th Place
- Additional placings may be added

ALL All Breed Division points to count from the following shows –

- April 18-19, Spring Salsa Sensation
- May 2-3, Roadrunner Classic
- July 18-19, Green Chile Classic
- August 15-16, Red Chile Fiesta
- October 17-18, Fall Color Roundup

All shows listed to be held at Wright's Rockin' Horse Arena in Stanley, NM

There is NO enrollment or nomination fee! ALL All Breed exhibitors are eligible to win!

All Breed exhibitor(s) must be a member of one of the sponsoring clubs before any points count towards awards.

An exhibitor (or horse in Open) must show in All Breed class(es) at three or more of the shows listed..

Points are earned for All Breed class placings UNDER EACH JUDGE regardless of how many are in a class. So, EVERY exhibitor in ANY division is eligible to win the High Point Awards.

Points will be kept by division and will not be combined from multiple divisions. Points in Open & Green Horse Divisions will be kept on horse (may have multiple exhibitors) and points in Rookie, Amateur (Non-Pro) and Youth Divisions will be kept on one horse /one rider.

Division Rules for **Roadrunner Classic only** –

For All Breed (AB) classes that do **not** designate a division (such as the AB Ranch Cutting, AB Western Pleasure, select walk/trot classes, etc), exhibitors may choose which division their point will apply to (Open, Amateur/Non-Pro, Rookie, Green or Youth).

- Points will be awarded as follows: **120 points for 1st, 105 for 2nd** and continuing per the standard point scale.
- Points may be applied to one **division only**.
- Exhibitor must declare their chosen division **within 10 days after the show**.
- It is the exhibitor's sole responsibility to make this declaration.
- If no declaration is made within 10 days, the points will automatically be applied to the **Open** division.
- If an AB class on the show schedule specifically lists a division (for example, AB Youth Trail), points from this class will automatically apply to that listed division. Exhibitors

may not redirect those points to another division, nor may they apply points from a similar AB class to that same division.

All Breed Award Program Point System:

Placing	Point Earned
1 st	120
2 nd	105
3 rd	91
4 th	78
5 th	66
6 th	55
7 th	45

Example: If you go in 10 classes in one division and win 1st in all the classes, you will have 1200 points even if you are the only person in your classes. If another competitor in a different division goes in 10 classes and gets 8 – 1st, 2 - 2nd out of 4, they will have 1070 points. A third exhibitor goes in 30 classes in a big division and gets 6th in every class, they will have 1650 points. The exhibitor with the 1650 points will win the High Point and the exhibitor with 1200 points will win the Reserve High Point and so on. This point system REWARDS frequency and consistency and makes it possible for any exhibitor in any division to win.

In the event of a tie, the exhibitor & horse (in amateur, rookie and youth divisions) or horse (in open and green divisions) with the most firsts will be used to break the tie. If a tie remains, the highest placing over the greatest number of horses will be used. If a tie still remains, a flip of coin will be used to determine winner.
