

Fall Color **ROUNDUP – October 23 – 23, 2022**

FUN CLASSES:

- Entry fee: \$12.00 per class.*
- JACKPOT 50% of entry fees (payout schedule: less than 5 in class – winner takes all; 5 – 10 in class – winner 60%, 2nd 40%; 11 – 15 in class – winner 50%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%; 16+ in class – winner 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%, 4th 10%.
- Fun classes do NOT count towards any high point show or year end awards.
- Prize to Winner of each class. Rosettes through sixth place.

Class #1 – All Breed Costume Class open to Horse Show Exhibitors (and family members) and Horses of any color or painted any color. Horse (equine) NOT required for entry in this class. Costume REQUIRED for exhibitor or horse or both. In hand only class, i.e. horse can be saddled but will not ridden in this class.

Class #119 – Stick Horse “MIX IT UP” Ranch Pattern Class (bring your own stick horse or ride one furnished by show management). Open to Horse Show Exhibitors (and family members). An abbreviated pattern (a smaller arena will be designated) using maneuvers and obstacles from ranch reining, ranch riding and/or ranch trail will be posted when ranch class patterns are posted. Open to all levels of competitors.

Class #203 – All Breed Adult Leadline open to All Horses (equines) entered in show. Parent, Grandparent, Spouse or Trainer to ride. Horse must be led by Child, Grandchild or Student (9 years of age or older) or Spouse. No stallions allowed in this class. Adult may exhibit in English or Western attire. Equipment on horse must correspond with exhibitor attire, including a saddle adjusted so that exhibitor’s feet are placed properly in stirrups. Exhibitors will enter ring at a flat footed walk. The class may be worked at a walk and/or trot both directions of the ring. In the lineup, the judge may ask the riders to back. The contestant must exhibit some knowledge of equitation. Judging will be on the rider. A lead shank of at least six feet long must be attached to the shank of the bit or to a halter that is under the bridle so that while the rider is in the ring, the horse is controlled by the handler (leader).

Class #276 – All Breed Western Fun Class – STICK HORSE Disciplined Rail Class (bring your own stick horse or ride one furnished by show management). Open to Horse Show Exhibitors (and family members). “Simon Says” rail class (a smaller arena will be designated) loosely based on Pinto disciplined rail classes. Come prepared for some fun.

Class #301 – All Breed English Fun Class – CHIN APPLE Disciplined Rail Class open to All Horses (equines) entered in show. “Simon Says” rail class based on Pinto disciplined rail classes all while holding an apple (real? or fake?) under your chin. Last rider to lose their apple will be declared the winner! Will you be ready for the challenge?

*Entry form required and NMPHC and/or APHA horse shows rules to be followed. NMPHC Board reserves right to clarify rules if needed. Their decisions will be final.
