Bernalillo County Regional 4-H Horse Show

4-H Awards and Ribbons:

Show High Point and Reserve High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been totaled for each division: Senior, Junior and Novice (based on one horse/one rider). Halter classes will not count toward show high point awards. All Exploration Age exhibitors will receive participation awards (points will not be tracked). Ribbons will be given for 1st through 6th place in each class, except Exploration Age classes. Exploration Age exhibitors will not be placed and will receive a participation ribbon for each class they enter.

4-H Additional Info:

- Bernalillo County is the 4-H Host County for this 4-H Show.
- **PRE ENTRY REQUIRED** for ALL 4-H participants. Pre-enter by March 24th. A current horse certificate for the 2023 year signed by your respective 4-H agent **MUST** accompany entry or you **WILL NOT** be allowed to show in the 4-H classes and points **WILL NOT** count for the State 4-H Horse Show Series.
- 4-H classes will be governed by NM State 4-H Horse Show Rules available from your county extension agent or by contacting Brittany Sonntag, Bernalillo County 4-H Agent, bsonntag@nmsu.edu or 505-243-1386
- Mail entries to Bernalillo County 4-H Horse Council, c/o Brittany Sonntag, 1510 Menaul, Blvd, NW, Albuquerque, NM 87107 OR email to bsonntag@nmsu.edu. A copy of your 2023 NM 4-H Horse Certificate signed by your County 4-H Extension Agent must accompany completed entry form and stall reservation form. At least one class must be entered on entry form.
- Additional classes may be added at the show including adding and scratching classes at the gate provided a completed entry form was submitted on time and a back number has been assigned.
- Stall reservation form must be submitted whether stalling at facility or hauling in each day.
- Pre-payment of entries or stalls is not required.
- Only 4-H classes will count for any 4-H Awards.

NM 4-H Horse Show rules state that a horse may only be shown by one rider and in one division. An exception will be made for Exploration Age riders. Exploration Age classes will be walk/trot only. If an Exploration Age exhibitor is uncomfortable trotting, they may stay at the walk. Parents may also help Exploration Age exhibitors with their horse in the arena, including the use of a leadline in all Exploration Age classes.

HELMETS ARE REQUIRED in all speed events and hunter under saddle classes (including hunt seat equitation and disciplined rail).
